MESSAGE RECAP

We are called or commissioned to go and proclaim the gospel of Jesus (Acts 1:8; Matt. 28:18-20). Taking a different approach with his Sunday message, Pastor David takes time this week to interview Don Finto, to take communion corporately, and to profess through public decrees our calling to engage others for the Kingdom of God. The heartbeat behind these different elements of the service is to encourage and solidify the conviction to go and proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ.

GETTING STARTED

1. How has the **Unleashed** series of the last few weeks affected you? Have you been stirred and sense the Holy Spirit leading you into new areas? Or if you were honest, has this series been challenging and uncomfortable?

GOING DEEPER

1. What does it mean to be *commissioned* for a specialized task or responsibility? Whom in scripture did God *commission* for a specific purpose, and how did they respond?
2. Does God *commission* believers today? If so, how does He *commission* them, and for what specific purposes? Does God *commission* all believers in some way?
3. How does the Holy Spirit give power to those He has called or *commissioned* (Acts 1:8)? What does that power look like practically?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

1. How might God be *commissioning* you for a specific purpose? Is He calling you to a specific type of ministry, or to a particular nation/region or people?
2. What is the first step to take in fulfilling your *commission*?

MINISTRY TIME

God has been stirring and calling people/families to new levels of action concerning the gospel of Jesus Christ and the Kingdom of God. **After you have a good sense of how God is commissioning those within your group, take time together to pray specifically over those individuals**, asking the Holy Spirit to empower and to guide them with wisdom as they take deliberate steps to live out that commissioning. Pray that the message of Jesus would be received and embraced, that hearts would be open to receiving Him.

NEIGHBORHOOD PRAYER WALKING

Take time toward the end of your Life Group gathering (approx. 20 minutes) to divide into smaller groups of 2-3 people to **walk and pray over a specific neighborhood** represented by someone in your group - this may require some planning for the next several weeks in terms of where you meet. Refer to the **Neighborhood Prayer Guide** for specific bullet points on how to pray as you walk (available at the **Unleashed** Information Table or online at www.beltwayunleashed.com/downloads and www.beltwayunleashed.com/lifegroups). Please be strategic in identifying and assigning specific streets to the smaller parties you send out.
